

Happy Four Patch

(36 x 48 inches)

FABRICS

Focus Fabric: 1 yard

Four Patch Block: 2 Fabrics, $\frac{3}{4}$ yard of each

Binding: $\frac{1}{2}$ yard



CUTTING

Focus Fabric: Cut 4 strips $6\frac{1}{2}$ inch x width of fabric. Subcut into (24) $6\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares

Four Patch fabrics: Cut 5 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide of both fabrics.
Subcut into (48) $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares of both fabrics.

Binding: cut 5 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide.

ASSEMBLY

4 patch blocks: Sew 2 contrasting $3\frac{1}{2}$ inch squares together into pairs. Press to dark. Join 2 pairs together, forming the 4 patch block. Blocks should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ inches square.

Layout quilt by alternating large and four patch blocks, 8 rows with 6 blocks per row.

Follow the picture, above. Join blocks and press.
