

SBSQC COMMUNITY QUILTS HUGS AND KISSES PATTERN

FEBRUARY 2016

Quilt Size: approximately 36" x 45"

Fabric Requirements:

For X's and O's (6 of each) you will need

½ yd each of 2 fabrics (cut 24 2 ½" squares from each fabric) **OR**

12 assorted prints (9" x 9" squares) cut into 4 ½" squares

For background

½ yd of white/light print or solid

1st border 1/4 yd

2nd border 1/2 yd

Backing 1 ½ yds

Binding ½ yd

Cutting Instructions

Print fabric – cut from each: 4 squares 4 ½" x 4 ½"

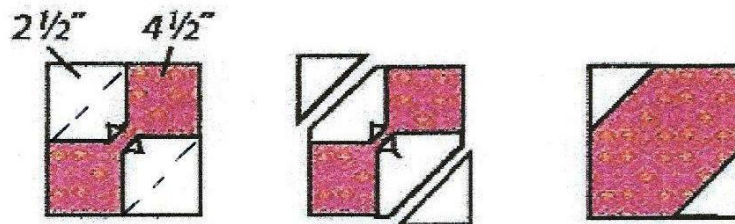
White/light print or solid - 96 squares 2 ½" x 2 ½"

1st border cut 1 ½" strips

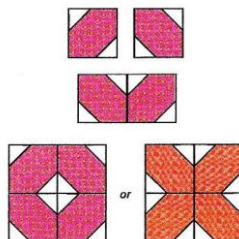
2nd border cut 4 ½" strips

Draw a diagonal line on wrong side of the white fabric 2 ½" squares. Place the marked squares on opposite corners of the print 4 ½" square, right sides together, align raw edges (see below).

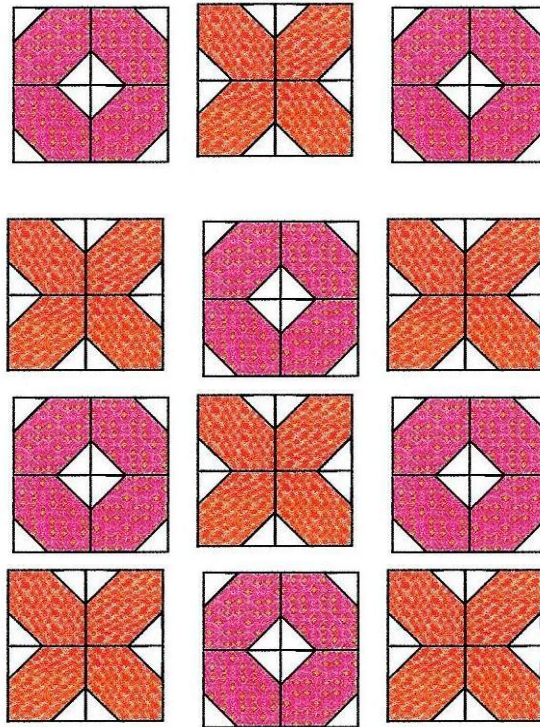
Sew on marked lines; trim excess corner fabric ¼" from stitching. Press one seam toward center and the other seam from center. .



Sew together the 4 matching pieced squares in either the "O" or "X" arrangement. You'll need a total of 6 "O"s and 6 "X"s.



Sew 4 rows of 3 blocks. Sew rows together.



Add borders. The sample quilt below has an inner accent border cut 1 1/2" and an outer border cut 4 1/2" wide. Quilt as desired. Bind.
