

SPIN BLOCK

This pattern uses SBS's 6" strips.

Finished Block: 10-1/2" X 10-1/2"
MAKE 20 BLOCKS.

Finished Quilt: 41" X 51"

To make ONE SCRAPPY BLOCK, choose a light background fabric and a dark fabric that are different for each block.

Cut TWO rectangles from EACH of two fabrics, 5-1/2" X 6".

Place one light rectangle and one dark rectangle right sides together.

Cut the rectangles down the middle forming two 3" X 5-1/2" rectangles. You will now have four sets 3" X 5-1/2" ready to sew together.

ASSEMBLY:

Sew rectangles together along the 5-1/2" side using a 1/4" seam, forming a 5-1/2" square. Press seams toward dark fabric.

Arrange four squares in pinwheel fashion, forming a large square with the dark fabric meeting in the middle (see top photo). Join as you would a 4-patch, pressing seams to the dark. This completes one block.

Sew 20 blocks together, four across and five down.

NOTE: For a quilt with MATCHING BACKGROUND in all blocks, you will need ONE YARD of fabric, cut into SIX WOF X 6" strips, and proceed with instructions for each block above.
