

Stacks of Color

(36 x 48 inches)

FABRICS

Focus Fabric: 1 yard

Strip Stacks Blocks:

Options:

- A. $\frac{1}{4}$ yard of 4 fabrics.
- B. 12 assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ by WOF strips.
- C. Or 108 assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ by $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch scrap fabric rectangles.

*NOTE: Width of Fabric (WOF) must be at least 41 inches of usable fabric or more fabric will be required.



CUTTING

Focus Fabric: Cut 3 strips $8\frac{1}{2}$ wide by width of fabric (WOF). Sub cut into 27 blocks that are $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide ($4\frac{1}{2}$ by $8\frac{1}{2}$)

Strip block: Option A: Cut fabrics into 12 strips, $2\frac{1}{2}$ wide by WOF.

Binding: cut 5 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ inches wide.

ASSEMBLY

Option A and B: Select 4 strips and sew together along the long edges to form a strip set that now measures $8\frac{1}{2}$ by $4\frac{1}{2}$ inches. Repeat process and make 2 additional strip sets. Sub cut into 27 blocks measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ by $8\frac{1}{2}$.

Option C: Join four $2\frac{1}{2}$ by $4\frac{1}{2}$ scrap rectangles to form a $4\frac{1}{2}$ by $8\frac{1}{2}$ inch rectangle. Repeat to make 27 blocks measuring $4\frac{1}{2}$ by $8\frac{1}{2}$.

Layout quilt by alternating large focus fabric rectangles and four piece strip set---6 rows with 9 blocks per row. Join blocks and press.
