

Colorwash Wreath

33"x36" plus optional borders

Supply List

Fabric:

- **Wreath** fabric – at least 6-8 fabrics. Total yardage needed is $\frac{3}{4}$ yard. Scraps or eighth-yard pieces are great, or fat quarters work, too.
- **Background** fabric – again at least 6-8 fabrics. Total yardage for the **background** is $1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards, so scraps, eighth-yard pieces or fat quarters are ideal.
- **Transition** fabric – at least 3-4 fabrics works well. This should be fabric with the colors of the wreath with the background color showing through. An example is if you are using soft floral pinks for your wreath, and cream as your background. The transition fabric should be on open print of soft pink flowers on cream. You will need a total of $\frac{1}{2}$ yard.
- **Ribbon** fabric should be four values of the same color. **Light** is $\frac{1}{8}$ yard. **Medium Light** is $\frac{1}{4}$ yard. **Medium Dark** is $\frac{1}{4}$ yard. **Dark** is $\frac{1}{4}$ yard.
- **Gridded Fusible Interfacing** – $1 \frac{1}{2}$ yards. It is available at A Stitch in Time Quilt Shoppe in 1", 2", and 2.5" – the 2" size is what you will need.
- **Binding** – $\frac{5}{8}$ yard of whatever color you choose.

The optional border(s) and binding are best selected after the quilt blocks have been assembled. Shown here is a 1" border.

Notions:

- ✓ Sewing machine and instructions, in good working order
- ✓ Rotary cutter and mat
- ✓ 6" x 24" Clear Acrylic Ruler
- ✓ June Taylor Shape Cut Ruler for subcutting squares (optional)
- ✓ Small ruler, at least 2"x2", to trim half-square triangle units
- ✓ Thread – neutral
- ✓ Stiletto
- ✓ Basic sewing supplies, i.e. scissors, pins, seam ripper
- ✓ Craft Iron
- ✓ Teflon pressing sheet or parchment paper
- ✓ Design wall or flannel sheet, at least 45"x50"
- ✓ Iron-on Fusible Web for appliqué (optional, for Day 2)
