

Landscape Quilt using Rose Hughes' fast-piece applique (or any method you prefer)

Version 2

A simple pattern will be supplied. The completed quilt measures 25" x 24", but you may wish to enlarge it or add borders. If you wish to work on your own pattern that is welcome.

This class is a benefit for Community Quilts and a \$20 donation is appreciated. Community Quilts wants to eliminate its landscape fabric, so that will be available at no additional charge and since we also have an abundance of greens, some will be available.

Supplies

Freezer paper to copy pattern pieces (I will supply)

Permanent pen such as a Sharpie

Paper scissors

Fabric scissors

Tape (masking, scotch, or painter's)

Safety pins (used to secure pattern pieces as you applique them)

Duck bill, applique scissors, or any small sharp scissors to safely cut away excess fabric

Fabric, including a sky piece at least 25" x 12"

Small pieces of yarn to applique over seams (I will furnish some earthtone yarns scraps)

Sewing machine in working order with zig zag capabilities preferred. The zig zag portion can be completed later.

Regular sewing supplies, including threads that will blend with your color scheme
