Do you want to break away from traditional patterns? The technique to use is called Collage to Quilt. We will follow Sarah Hibbert's 2021 book. Here's your chance to use paper, scissors and glue to create your own patterns. This 2-session workshop allows you to play with paper to create your patterns (session 1) and apply your design to fabric (session 2).

Supply List

Session 1: January 22

(Play with paper to create your patterns)

- Start saving colorful, distinctive mailers, pages from magazines
- Bring scrapbooking paper or origami paper too
- Get a small spiral bound sketch book
- As an extra get some smooth watercolor paper small package card size
- Paper scissors, exacto knife, cutting mat, plastic ruler
- Fine tip permanent marker and colored markers
- Good quality glue sticks
- Paper towels to glue on
- Small cardboard frame mat
- Paper cutting tools for squares, hexagons , hearts

Session 2: February 5

(Apply your design to fabric to create a small Joy-Quilt sized quilt)

- Background fabric solids would be best
- Fabric scraps in a variety of colors these can be prints but read as a solid
- Fabric scissors, rotary cutter, rulers
- Steam a seam
- Needles, thread, thimble, pins, or clips
- Sewing Machine with all your supplies
- Any basic supplies you like for sewing
